Violations Comments

Violation #5. Maintenance & Repair

1. Observed inoperable sink (1st sink) in girl's restroom (room 25) at time of inspection. Repair/replace inoperable sink.
2. Observed broken toilet seat cover in handicap stall (boy's restroom, room 23) at time of inspection. Repair/replace toilet seat.

CODE REFERENCE: Maintenance & Repair 64E-13.004(3)(b)(c). Buildings shall be kept clean and in good repair, free from hazardous conditions, such as loose or broken floor tiles and boards; loose moldings; loose hanging fixtures, pipes, and electric wires; and broken plaster. Furnishings and equipment shall be kept clean and in good repair, free of missing parts and hazards such as sharp edges, splinters, and protruding or rusty nails.

Violation #12. Toilet Facilities

No toilet paper observed in 1st stall of boy's restroom (room 23) at time of inspection. Provide toilet paper.

CODE REFERENCE: Toilet Facilities 64E-13.004(6)(a). Toilet facilities shall be accessible under continuous roof cover from all student occupied spaces. In group toilet rooms a partition shall be placed between each water closet. Each compartment shall have a door. Entrances to group toilet rooms shall be provided with a partition or other shielding device to block the occupants from view. Entrance doors shall be self-closing.
